

The student reflection of STARTALK program

It is mandatory to submit a reflection essay in order to help with planning of the next year's STARTALK program. The reflection is to be written in size 12 font, 1.5 spaced, font size 12, and have a minimum of one full page along with your name, school, and grade year in the upper right corner of the first page. The deadline to submit the reflection is Aug 5, 2008. You should start with a paragraph to summarize your reflection and then describe it in details with the rest of the essay. You may choose to write about any topic that you can come up with, as long as it has something to do with the main prompt.

Possible topics include:

1. What have you learned from the STARTALK class?
2. What are the most interest topics that taught in the class?
3. What were the most boring topics that taught in your class?
4. What were the most difficult parts of your learning?
5. What were the best parts of this program?
6. What could be improved in this program?
7. What are your goals for learning Chinese after this experience?
